2. Principals Report: (Principal McLeod)

- Introduction of new staff for the 2018/2019 school year.
- Student population is 209 which is a decrease from last year. The portables have been dismantled and the field is nice and open.
- Initiatives for this year are: Chromebooks, Google Classroom and Google appointment.
- Co-curriculars are already on the go. Water shed festival took place.
- There is a huge focus this year on Well-Being. The school implemented the "First 20 days of wellness" and the idea is to have a focus on all of the elements of well-being. There will be common language from K-8.
- It focuses on sources of support and how to help a friend get back into the green zone.

- Orange Shirt Day Sept. 30 (Connections to reconciliation)

School Plan

- EQAO results: some areas we did well and others not so well. The data will be released soon.
- Main focus on Equity/Inclusion and Well-Being.
- Early Reading Intervention is a large focus. Building that letter/sound recognition as well as building writing stamina.
- Primary focus also on Reading with Meaning.
- Math focus: automaticity (use of math games, number facts, and the use of math tools and strategies)
- Last year, many students were hesitant to use the manipulatives to help so teachers are training them to use them.
- Self- Regulation remains a focus. Students will practice knowing what zone they are in and how to get back to the green zone.

- The school also has a Girl Empowerment club. A student attitudinal survey was conducted and unfortunately, the majority of social conflict and bullying has been from the girls.
- The club helps model appropriate ways to deal with each other.
- In terms of Equity, the school's goals are to meet students needs daily, as well as build independence and focus more on learning skills rather than academics.

6. Financial Update: (Mr. McLeod)

- Opening Balance was \$1076.
- Allocated Funds: Projection and Sound Equipment \$8735.20 (After receiving 3 different quotes we now know that the equipment will cost around \$15,000)
- Nova's Ark Field Trip: \$1156.53
- Subscriptions: \$500
- Recess Equipment: \$450
- We aren't sure yet what we brought in from the Welcome Back BBQ.
- It was suggested that we give the money to the grade 8 fundraising committee. We decided to wait and see what was brought in first.
- Erin and Alli were to go shopping ASAP to purchase recess equipment.
- There was discussion about Grade 8 Grad and how fundraising makes the Grad trip more affordable to families. Typically, trips run between \$300-\$500.
- It was mentioned that many schools are shifting away from the dance idea and rather going out for dinner to celebrate the end of Grade 8.
